A12 Works – Easthorpe – Marks Tey

Highways England is undertaking necessary maintenance works on the A12 at the above location, clearing vegetation, improving the carriageway surface and replacing faded road markings, studs and signs.

We plan to complete this work over **5 weeks**, starting **Tuesday 26 May**, with working hours between **9pm and 5am**, weather depending. Should there be a requirement to significantly re-programme the work, a further notification will be issued.

Traffic restrictions

To minimise the impact on local communities and road users, we will only divert traffic from the A12 onto local roads, where absolutely necessary. Where this is required, we have liaised with the local authority to agree the most reasonable route.

The following closures will be in place.

- **Lane closures** on the A12 **eastbound** between Kelvedon and Colchester from **Tuesday 26 May to Friday 29 May** and **Monday 22 June to Tuesday 23 June, weeknights only.**
- **Full closure** of the A12 **eastbound** between Kelvedon and Colchester on **Saturday 30 May, Sunday 31 May, Saturday 6 June and Sunday 7 June (Diagram A).**
- **Lane closures** of the A12 **westbound** between Colchester and Kelvedon from **Monday 1 June to Friday 12 June, weeknights only.**
- **Full closure** of the A12 **westbound** between Colchester and Kelvedon on **Saturday 13 June, Sunday 14 June, Saturday 20 June and Sunday 21 June (Diagram B).**

Please note these works are subject to weather conditions and dates may change, notices onsite will provide the most up to date information.

We have included a diversion map for these closures at the end of this letter.

Access and disruption

Access for emergency vehicles will be allowed at all times.

Due to the nature of the works being carried out, noise and light disturbance is unavoidable. We will however attempt to keep this to a minimum. Please accept our apologies in advance of any inconvenience that is caused whilst work is in progress.

Safety

Your safety is important to us, as is the safety of our operatives working on site. We would be grateful if you could observe signs and restrictions in place as any unauthorised access to the site creates a serious risk to safety of everyone involved.

Our roads remain open and we will continue to maintain the network, ensuring that life-saving medicine, equipment, supplies and healthcare staff can travel to where they are needed most.

All our sites have strict safeguarding measures to prevent the spread of COVID19 and none of our sites are open to the public.

To continue along the A12 eastbound, exit at junction 19 and take the diversion via A130, A131, A120, B1408 and A1124 before re-joining the A12 at junction 26.

We expect this diversion to add approximately 20 - 25 minutes to the usual journey. Please take this into consideration when planning your journey.

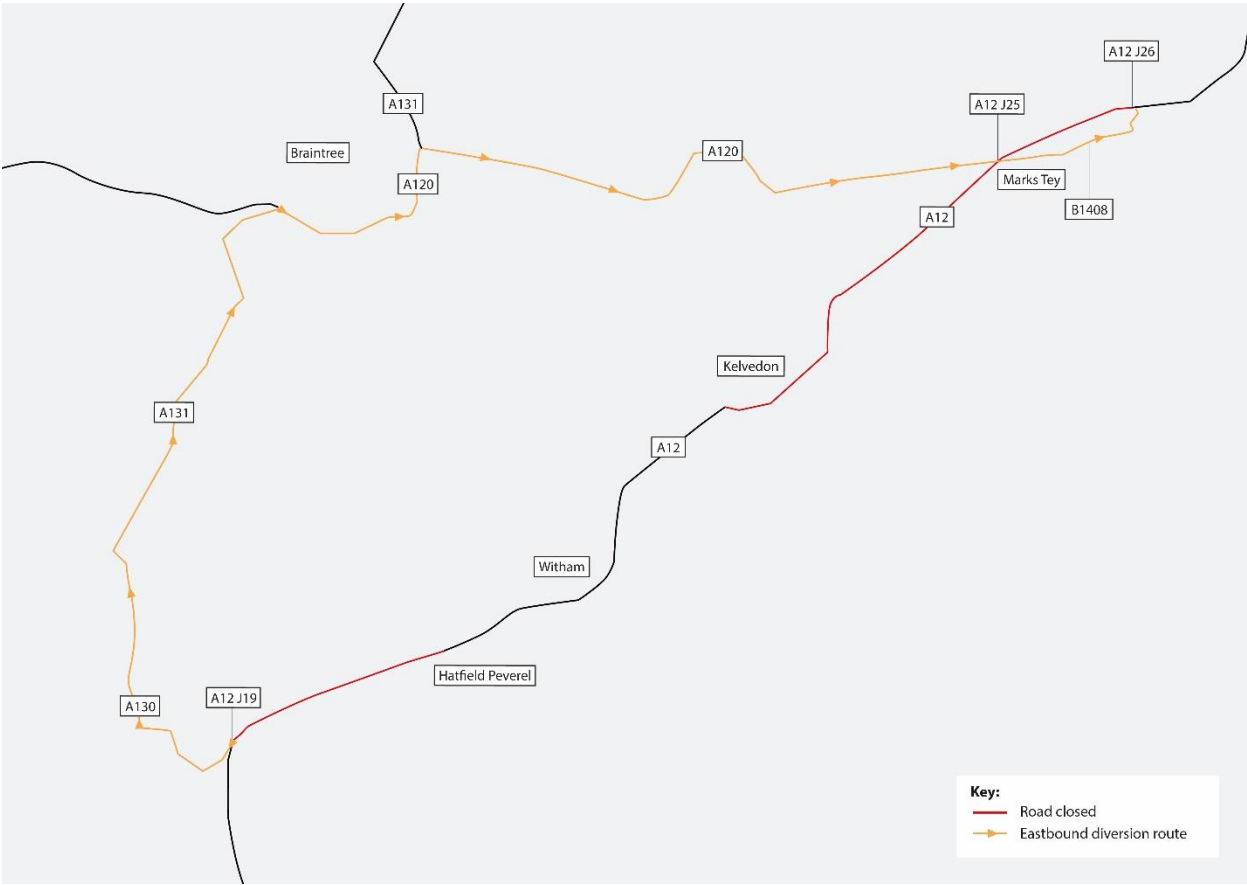

A12 Westbound Closure – Saturday 13 June, Sunday 14 June, Saturday 20 June and Sunday 21 June between 9pm and 5am each night

To continue along the A12 westbound, exit at junction 26 and take the diversion via A1124, B1408, A120, A131 and A130 before re-joining the A12 at junction 19.

We expect this diversion to add approximately 20 - 25 minutes to the usual journey. Please take this into consideration when planning your journey.
