Progress update

Following the temporary utility diversions main works have commenced. Excavations for the VRS foundations on the South side of the bridge are complete and work will now start on the next stage, which includes installing steel reinforcement for concrete foundations.

The brick wall, which was in a poor condition on the North side of the bridge, has been demolished and the area has been excavated and blinded ready for the construction of the VRS foundations.
