Subject: Essex Highways: Parish Council information – Marks Tey Station Bridge

I am writing to draw your attention to the latest website update on the [Marks Tey Station Bridge, Vehicle Restraint System \(VRS\)](#) webpage.

Progress update

The installation of the vehicle restraint system (VRS) at Marks Tey Station Bridge is nearing completion and we are aiming to reopen North Lane to all vehicles by the end of the day on Friday 6 November 2020.

There are some outstanding work relating to the scheme, including work to install fencing as the material has been delayed and installing a lamp column in the vicinity of the bridge. These activities will take place at a later date managed by two-way traffic lights. As soon as dates are confirmed, we will provide a further update.

Carriageway resurfacing will be taking place on a section of North Lane from **Monday 23 November 2020 for approximately three nights**. In order to carry out the work safely an overnight road closure will be required. A signed diversion will be in place during the temporary closure.
