Notification of A12 works – Marks Tey to Stanway

I am writing to inform you that we plan to undertake necessary work on the A12 to carry out concrete and ground investigation surveys.

The surveys are planned to start on **Monday 22 March** and are programmed to take approximately **3 weeks**. Our working times will be between the hours of **8pm** and **6am** each night. Should there be a requirement to significantly re-programme the work, a further notification will be issued.

Traffic restrictions

To minimise the impact on local communities and motorists, we will only divert traffic from the A12 onto local roads where absolutely necessary. Where this is required, we have liaised with Essex County Council to agree the most reasonable route.

The following closures will be in place.

- **Closure** of the A12 **northbound** between junction 25 and junction 26 from **Monday 22 March** up to and including **Sunday 28 March** between **8pm** and **6am** each night (**Diagram A**)
- **Closure** of the A12 **southbound** between junction 26 and junction 25 from **Monday 29 March** up to and including **Wednesday 31 March** and **Tuesday 6 April** up to and including **Friday 9 April** between **8pm** and **6am** each night (**Diagram B**).

Please note these works are subject to weather conditions and dates may change, notices onsite will provide the most up to date information.

I have included diversion maps for these closures at the end of this letter.

Access and disruption

Access for emergency vehicles will be allowed at all times.

Due to the nature of the works being carried out, noise and light disturbance is unavoidable. We will however attempt to keep this to a minimum. Please accept our apologies in advance of any inconvenience that is caused whilst work is in progress.

Safety

Your safety is important to us, as is the safety of our operatives working on site. We would be grateful if you could observe signs and restrictions in place as any unauthorised access to the site creates a serious risk to safety of everyone involved.

Our roads remain open and we will continue to maintain the network, ensuring that life-saving medicine, equipment, supplies and healthcare staff can travel to where they are needed most.

All our sites have strict safeguarding measures to prevent the spread of COVID19 and none of our sites are open to the public.

A12 Northbound Closure – Monday 22 March up to and including Sunday 28 March between 8pm and 6am each night

To continue along the A12 northbound, exit at junction 25 and take the diversion via A120, B1408/London Road and A1124 before re-joining the A12 at junction 26.

We expect this diversion to add approximately 5 - 10 minutes to the usual journey. Please take this into consideration when planning your journey.

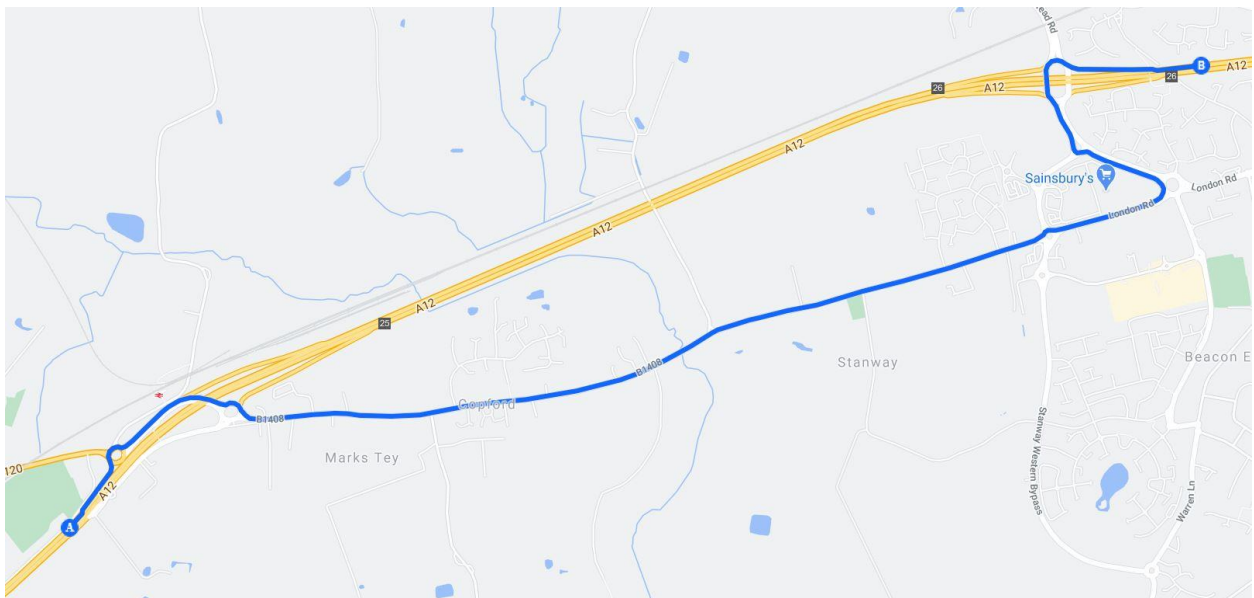

A12 Southbound Closure – Monday 29 March up to and including Wednesday 31 March and Tuesday 6 April up to and including Friday 9 April between 8pm and 6am each night

To continue along the A12 southbound, exit at junction 26 and take the diversion via A1124, B1408/London Road and A120 before re-joining the A12 at junction 25.

We expect this diversion to add approximately 5 – 10 minutes to the usual journey. Please take this into consideration when planning your journey.
